



# PERSATUAN STEDFAST KUALA LUMPUR

## RULES AND GOVERNING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Scholarships given to applicants shall be decided by the Executive Committee of Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur or any Sub-Committee so appointed by the Executive Committee. Decisions of the Sub-Committee shall be referred to the Executive Committee for final ratification.
2. Scholarships shall be given free of interest to suitably qualified members of The Boys' Brigade, Officers of The Boys' Brigade or former members of The Boys' Brigade.
3. The Executive Committee shall have the prerogative to award such Scholarship to any applicant who have contributed to the development of The Boys' Brigade movement directly or indirectly through immediate members of the family.
4. This Scholarship is only applicable for local studies only.
5. The Scholarship may be in a form of a grant, loan or a mix of grant and loan, and shall solely be used to assist recipient to further their education interest. However, the Executive Committee, at its discretion, may award such Grant or Loan to provide humanitarian assistance to deserving applicants or causes.
6. Whether the Scholarship shall be a Grant or Loan shall be decided by the Executive Committee of the Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur.
7. Any Scholarship awarded shall be disbursed by the Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur directly to the institution where the recipients is pursuing his/her course of study. Only awards for personal expenses or for welfare or humanitarian reasons may be disbursed to the recipients.
8. Recipients awarded the Scholarship for educational purpose shall without fail, submit each semester/term examination results to the Hon. Secretary not later than a fortnight after the release of the results.
9. The Scholarship is awarded annually and recipients must apply each year.
10. A recipient of a Scholarship shall sign to indemnify the Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur should he/she fail to diligently pursue his/her course of study or indulge in undesirable or immoral behaviour which is not consonant with the behaviour expected of a member of The Boys' Brigade movement.
11. A recipient of a Loan shall begin repayment by monthly installment of not less than one hundred (RM 100.00) two months after he/she receives the first month salary until the Grant or Loan is fully repaid.

12. Recipients of the Scholarship from Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur are expected at all times to be of good moral behaviour, diligently and seriously apply himself/herself to the chosen course of studies and endeavour to do his/her best to pass all examination or test and refrain from drug abuse, consumption of banned substances and indulgence in behaviour which contravenes the country's laws.
13. A recipient of any Scholarship must join as a member of the Association upon receiving the scholarship.
14. A recipient in breach of any rules governing the award of a Scholarship or relinquishes his/her course of studies in mid-course, shall be required to repay the Grant or Loan in Full.
15. The Executive Committee of Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur reserves the right to convert a Loan into a Grant or to decide on the quantum of monthly repayment of the Loan.
16. In all matters pertaining to the applications for the Scholarship, the Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur Executive Committee's decision will be final.

### **Instructions for Application**

1. One copy of the application form is to be completed and returned to the Hon. Secretary of Persatuan Stedfast Kuala Lumpur by 31<sup>st</sup> March.
2. Incomplete and/or incorrect information may cause your application to be rejected.
3. To enclose certified photocopies of the following documents with the application :
  - a) New Identification Card
  - b) Birth Certificate
  - c) Past Public Examination Results
  - d) If you are studying in a tertiary institution, a copy of latest examination results
  - e) Testimonials from your principal, Dean of Faculty, etc
  - f) If you are a member of The Boys' Brigade, a copy of testimonial from either the Captain or the Chaplain of the Company
  - g) Or any documents that is required from the application form.
